We have an upcoming maternity-leave position, commencing from the beginning of Term 3, 2017 (July 17). We are seeking a suitably qualified, skilled and experienced Steiner teacher to guide our Class 6 (a cohesive group of 15 students) through the final phase of their primary schooling and prepare them for transition to an external secondary school.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the overall teaching of the class, nurturing the social and emotional development of the class and individuals, and overseeing the specialist program for the class. You will need to be dynamic and creative, working with the educational principles inspired by Rudolf Steiner, whilst being committed to a high standard in teaching and professional learning.

At the end of the 2017 school year, an opportunity will exist to apply for another teaching role in the school, the tenure of which would be for the remainder of the maternity leave period (initially for the first 6 months of 2018). This teaching position may be in a junior class.
